RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE CORRECTIONS; AP-2 PROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE CORRECTIONS FOR FISCAL 3 YEAR 2024; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT PO-4 SITIONS; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE 5 CORRECTIONS FOR THE COMMUNITY, OPERATIONS, AND PROGRAM SERVICES PRO-6 GRAM FOR YOUTH ASSESSMENT CENTERS; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHOR-7 ITY FOR YOUTH ASSESSMENT CENTERS; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY 8 FOR FURNITURE AND FIXTURES; PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS; AND 9 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES. 10

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Juvenile Corrections the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Department of Juvenile Corrections is authorized no more than four hundred nine (409.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 125, Laws of 2022, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Department of Juvenile Corrections, for the Community, Operations, and Program Services Program, \$4,100,000 from the General Fund, to be expended for trustee and benefit payments, for the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, for the purpose of youth assessment centers.

35 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR YOUTH ASSESSMENT CENTERS.
36 There is hereby reappropriated to the Department of Juvenile Corrections
37 any unexpended and unencumbered balances appropriated to the Department
38 of Juvenile Corrections from the General Fund for Youth Assessment Centers
39 for fiscal year 2023, in an amount not to exceed \$4,100,000 from the General

Fund, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures related to Youth Assessment
Centers for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. The Office of the
State Controller shall confirm the reappropriation amount, by fund, expense
class, and program, with the Legislative Services Office prior to processing
the reappropriation authorized herein.

6 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR FURNITURE AND FIXTURES. There is hereby reappropriated to the Department of Juvenile Corrections any unex-7 pended and unencumbered balances appropriated to the Department of Juvenile 8 Corrections from the General Fund for cottage furniture and fixtures at its 9 St. Anthony facility for fiscal year 2023, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 10 from the General Fund, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures related to 11 cottage furniture and fixtures for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 12 2024. The Office of the State Controller shall confirm the reappropriation 13 amount, by fund, expense class, and program, with the Legislative Services 14 15 Office prior to processing the reappropriation authorized herein.

SECTION 6. ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. Funds specifically identified in statute or in an appropriation act as intended for a certain purpose may be used only for that purpose. All funds provided in this act shall be subject to accountability reports and management reviews in accordance with Section 67-702, Idaho Code.

SECTION 7. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, Sections 1,2,4,5, and 6 of this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2023, and Section 3 of this act shall be in full force and effect on and after passage and approval.
