AN ACT

1 RELATING TO VOTER IDENTIFICATION; AMENDING SECTION 34-404, IDAHO CODE,  
2 TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING THE REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS; AMEND-  
3 ING SECTION 34-408, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE A PROVISION REGARDING THE  
4 REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS; AMENDING SECTION 34-408A, IDAHO CODE, TO RE-  
5 VISE PROVISIONS REGARDING ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION; AMENDING SECTION  
6 34-410, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING MAIL REGISTRATION;  
7 AMENDING SECTION 34-411, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING THE  
8 APPLICATION FOR ELECTOR REGISTRATION AND ELECTOR PROOF OF IDENTITY AND  
9 RESIDENCE; REPEALING SECTION 34-416, IDAHO CODE, RELATING TO REGIS-  
10 TRATION APPLICATIONS; AMENDING SECTION 49-315, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE A  
11 PROVISION REGARDING DRIVER'S LICENSES; AMENDING SECTION 49-2444, IDAHO  
12 CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR A CERTAIN NO-FEE IDENTIFICATION CARD, TO MAKE A  
13 CODIFIER'S CORRECTION, AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND DECLAR-  
14 ING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.  
15

16 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

17 SECTION 1. That Section 34-404, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
18 amended to read as follows:

19 34-404. REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS -- POLITICAL PARTY AFFILIATION --  
20 UNAFFILIATED DESIGNATION. (1) All electors must register before being able  
21 to vote at any primary, general, special, school or any other election gov-  
22 erned by the provisions of title 34, Idaho Code. Registration of a qualified  
23 person occurs when a legible, accurate and complete registration applica-  
24 tion ~~is~~ and proof of identity and residence are received in the office of  
25 the county clerk or ~~is received~~ at the polls pursuant to section 34-408(3),  
26 34-408A, or 34-1012, Idaho Code.

27 (2) Each elector may select on the registration application an af-  
28 filiation with a political party qualified to participate in elections  
29 pursuant to section 34-501, Idaho Code, or may select to be designated as  
30 "unaffiliated." The county clerk shall record the party affiliation or  
31 "unaffiliated" designation so selected as part of the elector's registra-  
32 tion record. If an elector shall fail or refuse to make such a selection, the  
33 county clerk shall enter on the registration records that such elector is  
34 "unaffiliated."

35 (3) In order to provide an elector with the appropriate primary elec-  
36 tion ballot, pursuant to section 34-904A, Idaho Code, the poll book for  
37 primary elections shall include the party affiliation or designation as  
38 "unaffiliated" for each elector so registered. An "unaffiliated" elector  
39 shall declare to the poll worker which primary election ballot the elec-  
40 tor chooses to vote in, pursuant to section 34-904A, Idaho Code, and the  
41 poll worker or other authorized election personnel shall record such dec-  
42 laration in the poll book. The poll book shall contain checkoff boxes to

1 allow the poll worker or other authorized election personnel to record such  
2 "unaffiliated" elector's selection.

3 ~~(4) In order to provide electors who are already registered to vote, and  
4 who remain registered electors, with an opportunity to select a party af-  
5 filiation or to select their status as "unaffiliated," the poll book for the  
6 2012 primary election shall include checkoff boxes by which the poll worker  
7 or other appropriate election personnel shall record such elector's choice  
8 of party affiliation or choice to be designated as "unaffiliated." After the  
9 2012 primary election, the county clerk shall record the party affiliation  
10 or "unaffiliated" designation so selected in the poll book as part of such  
11 an elector's record within the voter registration system as provided for in  
12 section 34-437A, Idaho Code.~~

13 ~~(5) After the 2012 primary election, electors who remain registered  
14 voters and who did not vote in the 2012 primary election or who have not  
15 selected party affiliation or who have not selected to be designated as  
16 "unaffiliated," shall be designated as "unaffiliated" and the county clerk  
17 shall record that designation for each such elector within the voter regis-  
18 tration system as provided for in section 34-437A, Idaho Code.~~

19 SECTION 2. That Section 34-408, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
20 amended to read as follows:

21 34-408. CLOSING OF REGISTER -- TIME LIMIT. (1) No elector may register  
22 in the office of the county clerk within twenty-four (24) days preceding any  
23 election held throughout the county in which he resides for the purpose of  
24 voting at such election; provided however, a legible, accurate and complete  
25 registration application received in the office of the county clerk during  
26 the twenty-four (24) day period preceding an election shall be accepted and  
27 held by the county clerk until the day following the election when registra-  
28 tion reopens, at which time the registration shall become effective. This  
29 deadline shall also apply to any registrars the county clerk may have ap-  
30 pointed.

31 (2) Any elector who will complete his residence requirement or attain  
32 the requisite voting age during the period when the register of electors is  
33 closed may register prior to the closing of the register.

34 ~~(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, an individual who  
35 is eligible to vote may also register, upon providing proof of residence,  
36 at the "absent electors' polling place" provided in section 34-1006, Idaho  
37 Code.~~ Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, an individual who  
38 is eligible to vote may also register, upon completing a registration ap-  
39 plication and showing proof of identity and residence pursuant to section  
40 34-411, Idaho Code, at the absent electors' polling place provided in sec-  
41 tion 34-1006, Idaho Code, or at an early voting station provided in section  
42 34-1012, Idaho Code.

43 SECTION 3. That Section 34-408A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
44 amended to read as follows:

45 34-408A. ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION. (1) An individual who is eligible  
46 to vote may register on election day by appearing in person at the polling  
47 place for the precinct in which the individual maintains residence, ~~by com-~~

1 pleting a registration application, showing proof of identity and residence  
 2 pursuant to section 34-411, Idaho Code, and making an oath in the form pre-  
 3 scribed by the secretary of state. and providing proof of residence. An in-  
 4 dividual may prove residence for purposes of registering by:

5 ~~(1) Showing an Idaho driver's license or Idaho identification card is-~~  
 6 ~~sued through the department of transportation; or~~

7 ~~(2) Showing any document which contains a valid address in the precinct~~  
 8 ~~together with a picture identification card; or~~

9 ~~(3) Showing a current valid student photo identification card from~~  
 10 ~~a postsecondary educational institution in Idaho accompanied with a cur-~~  
 11 ~~rent student fee statement that contains the student's valid address in the~~  
 12 ~~precinct.~~

13 (2) Election day registration provided in this section shall apply to  
 14 all elections conducted under title 34, Idaho Code, and to school district  
 15 and municipal elections.

16 An individual who is eligible to vote may also register, upon providing  
 17 proof of residence, at the "absent electors' polling place" provided in sec-  
 18 tion 34-1006, Idaho Code.

19 SECTION 4. That Section 34-410, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
 20 amended to read as follows:

21 34-410. MAIL REGISTRATION. (1) Any elector may register by mail for  
 22 any election. Any mail registration application must be received by the  
 23 county clerk prior to the close of registration as provided in section  
 24 34-408, Idaho Code, provided that any mail registration application post-  
 25 marked not later than twenty-five (25) days prior to an election shall be  
 26 deemed timely.

27 (2) The secretary of state shall prescribe the form for the mail regis-  
 28 tration application.

29 (3) ~~This~~ The mail application form shall be available for distribution  
 30 through governmental and private entities, with particular emphasis on mak-  
 31 ing them available for organized voter registration programs.

32 (4) Any federal mail registration form adopted pursuant to the provi-  
 33 sions of the national voter registration act of 1993 (P.L. 103-31) shall also  
 34 be accepted as a valid registration, if such form is postmarked not later  
 35 than twenty-five (25) days prior to an election.

36 (5) The county clerk shall prepare and issue by first class nonforward-  
 37 able mail to each elector registering by mail a verification of registration  
 38 containing the name and residence of the elector and the name or number of the  
 39 precinct in which the elector resides. A verification returned undeliver-  
 40 able shall cause the county clerk to remove the elector's card from the reg-  
 41 ister of electors.

42 (6) As required by the help America vote act of 2002 (P.L. 107-252), a  
 43 copy of proper identification will be required prior to issuance of a ballot  
 44 to anyone who has registered by mail and has not previously voted in an elec-  
 45 tion for federal office in the state. Proper identification consists of:

46 ~~(1) A current and valid photo identification; or~~

47 ~~(2) A copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check,~~  
 48 ~~paycheck, or other government document that shows the name and address of the~~  
 49 ~~voter. shall meet the requirements of section 34-411 (3) and (4), Idaho Code.~~

1 SECTION 5. That Section 34-411, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 34-411. APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION -- CONTENTS -- PROOF OF IDENTITY  
4 AND RESIDENCE. (1) ~~Each elector who requests registration shall supply the~~  
5 ~~following information under oath or affirmation:~~ The secretary of state  
6 shall prescribe the form for the registration application consistent with  
7 the provisions of this section. Each elector who requests registration  
8 shall show proof of identity and residence in accordance with subsections  
9 (3) and (4) of this section and shall supply the following information under  
10 oath or affirmation:

11 (a) Full name and sex-;

12 (b) ~~Mailing address, residence~~ Residence address or any other neces-  
13 sary information definitely locating the elector's residence-;

14 (c) Mailing address, if different from residence address;

15 ~~(e) (d)~~ The period of time preceding the date of registration during  
16 which the elector has resided in the state-;

17 ~~(d) (e)~~ Whether or not the elector is a citizen-;

18 ~~(e) (f)~~ That the elector is under no legal disqualifications to vote-;

19 ~~(f) (g)~~ The county and state where the elector was previously regis-  
20 tered, if any-;

21 ~~(g) (h)~~ Date of birth-; and

22 ~~(h) (i)~~ Current driver's license number or identification card issued  
23 by the Idaho transportation department. In the absence of an Idaho  
24 driver's license or state issued identification card, the last four (4)  
25 digits of the elector's social security number.

26 (2) As provided for in section 34-404, Idaho Code, each elector shall  
27 select an affiliation with a political party qualified to participate in  
28 elections pursuant to section 34-501, Idaho Code, or select to be desig-  
29 nated as "unaffiliated." The selection of party affiliation or designation  
30 as "unaffiliated" shall be maintained within the voter registration sys-  
31 tem as provided for in section 34-437A, Idaho Code. If an elector shall  
32 fail or refuse to make such a selection, the county clerk shall record as  
33 "unaffiliated" such elector within the voter registration system as pro-  
34 vided for in section 34-437A, Idaho Code.

35 (3) An individual shall prove identity for the purpose of registering  
36 to vote by showing one (1) of the following forms of photo identification:

37 (a) A current driver's license or identification card issued pursuant  
38 to title 49, Idaho Code;

39 (b) A current passport or other identification card issued by an agency  
40 of the United States government;

41 (c) A current tribal identification card; or

42 (d) A current license or enhanced license to carry concealed weapons  
43 issued under section 18-3302, Idaho Code, or section 18-3302K, Idaho  
44 Code.

45 (4) (a) An individual shall prove residence for the purpose of register-  
46 ing to vote by showing one (1) of the following documents that displays  
47 the applicant's name and current Idaho physical address:

48 (i) Any form of photo identification listed in subsection

49 (3) (a), (c), or (d) of this section;

- 1           (ii) A current proof of insurance;  
 2           (iii) A deed of trust, mortgage, or lease or rental agreement;  
 3           (iv) A property tax assessment, bill, or receipt;  
 4           (v) A utility bill, excluding a cellular telephone bill;  
 5           (vi) A bank or credit card statement;  
 6           (vii) A paystub, paycheck, or government-issued check;  
 7           (viii) An intake document from a residential care or assisted liv-  
 8           ing facility licensed pursuant to the provisions of chapter 33,  
 9           title 39, Idaho Code;  
 10           (ix) Enrollment papers issued for the current school year by a  
 11           high school or an accredited institution of higher education lo-  
 12           located within the state of Idaho; or  
 13           (x) A communication on letterhead from a public or private so-  
 14           cial service agency registered with the secretary of state veri-  
 15           fying the applicant is homeless and attesting to the applicant's  
 16           residence for registration purposes.

17           (b) Any document that displays only a post office box address does not  
 18           satisfy the requirements of this subsection.

19           (5) (a) The registration application shall contain the following warn-  
 20           ing:

21                   WARNING: Any elector who supplies any information,  
 22                   knowing it to be false, is guilty of perjury.

23           (b) The elector shall read the warning set forth in this subsection and  
 24           shall sign the elector's name in an appropriate place on the completed  
 25           application.

26           (6) The registration application completed and signed as provided in  
 27           this section constitutes the official registration application of the elec-  
 28           tor. The county clerk shall upload such applications to the statewide voter  
 29           registration database. Such applications shall be considered confidential  
 30           and unavailable for public inspection and copying except as provided by sec-  
 31           tion 74-106(25), Idaho Code.

32           ~~(3)~~ (7) Any elector who shall supply any information under subsection  
 33           (1) of this section, knowing it to be false, is guilty of perjury.

34           ~~(4)~~ (8) Each elector who requests registration may, at the elector's  
 35           option, supply the elector's telephone number. If the telephone number is  
 36           supplied by the elector, the telephone number shall be available to the pub-  
 37           lic.

38           (9) The statewide voter registration database maintained by the office  
 39           of the secretary of state shall constitute the register of electors.

40           SECTION 6. That Section [34-416](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
 41           repealed.

42           SECTION 7. That Section 49-315, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
 43           amended to read as follows:

44           49-315. LICENSES ISSUED TO DRIVERS. (1) The department shall issue  
 45           to every qualifying applicant a distinguishing driver's license as applied  
 46           for, which shall bear a distinguishing number assigned to the licensee, the

1 full name, date of birth, Idaho residence address, sex, weight, height, eye  
2 color, hair color, color photograph, name of this state, date of issuance,  
3 date of expiration, license class, endorsements, restrictions, and the ap-  
4 plicant's signature. If an applicant has submitted an application pursuant  
5 to the provisions of chapter 58, title 19, Idaho Code, then the applicant's  
6 driver's license shall contain his or her alternative Idaho mailing address  
7 in place of his or her Idaho residence address. Driver's licenses for per-  
8 sons under eighteen (18) years of age shall include a notation "under 18  
9 until (month, day, year)," and driver's licenses for persons eighteen (18)  
10 years of age to twenty-one (21) years of age shall include a notation "under  
11 21 until (month, day, year)." No driver's license shall be valid until it has  
12 been signed on the signature line of the license by the licensee. Driver's  
13 licenses for persons who are United States citizens ~~may~~ shall, where possi-  
14 ble, include the notation "USA."

15 (2) Every driver's license shall bear a color photograph of the li-  
16 censee, which shall be taken by the examiner at the time the application is  
17 made. The photograph shall be taken without headgear or other clothing or  
18 device that disguises or otherwise conceals the face or head of the appli-  
19 cant. A waiver may be granted by the department allowing the applicant to  
20 wear headgear or other head covering for medical, religious or safety pur-  
21 poses as long as the face is not disguised or otherwise concealed. At the  
22 request of the applicant, a driver's license may contain a statement or indi-  
23 cation of the medical condition of the licensee.

24 (3) The department shall notify the commercial driver license infor-  
25 mation system that a class A, B or C driver's license has been issued as re-  
26 quired by 49 CFR parts 383 and 384.

27 (4) A licensee applying for a hazardous material endorsement on a  
28 driver's license shall have a security background records check and shall  
29 receive clearance from the federal transportation security administration  
30 before the endorsement can be issued, renewed or transferred as required  
31 by 49 CFR part 383, subject to procedures established by the federal trans-  
32 portation security administration.

33 (5) A licensee who desires to donate any or all organs or tissue in the  
34 event of death, and who has completed a document of gift pursuant to the pro-  
35 visions for donation of anatomical gifts as set forth in chapter 34, title  
36 39, Idaho Code, may, at the option of the donor, indicate this desire on the  
37 driver's license by the imprinting of the word "donor" on the license. The  
38 provisions of this subsection shall apply to licensees fifteen (15) years of  
39 age or older but less than eighteen (18) years of age if the requirements pro-  
40 vided in chapter 34, title 39, Idaho Code, have been complied with and the  
41 donor indicates this desire be placed on the license.

42 (6) A licensee who is a person with a permanent disability may request  
43 that the notation "permanently disabled" be imprinted on the driver's li-  
44 cense, provided the licensee presents written certification from a licensed  
45 physician verifying that the licensee's stated impairment qualifies as a  
46 permanent disability according to the provisions of section 49-117, Idaho  
47 Code.

48 (7) A licensee who is a veteran may request that his or her status as  
49 such be designated on the driver's license at no additional cost. Any such  
50 request shall be accompanied by proof of being a current or former member of

1 the United States armed forces. Upon request and submission of satisfactory  
2 proof, the department shall indicate such person's status as a veteran on any  
3 class of driver's license issued pursuant to this section. Such designation  
4 shall be made upon original issuance or renewal of a driver's license. Des-  
5 ignation shall also be made on any duplicate driver's license issued, pro-  
6 vided that the fee for such duplicate driver's license is paid in accordance  
7 with section 49-306, Idaho Code.

8 Satisfactory proof of being a current or former member of the United  
9 States armed forces must be furnished by an applicant to the department  
10 before a designation of veteran status will be indicated on any class of  
11 driver's license. Acceptable proof shall be a copy of form DD214 or an equiv-  
12 alent document or statement from the department of veterans affairs that  
13 identifies a character of service upon separation as "honorable" or "general  
14 under honorable conditions."

15 SECTION 8. That Section 49-2444, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 49-2444. IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED -- FOUR-YEAR OR EIGHT-YEAR. (1)  
18 The department shall issue a distinguishing identification card that shall  
19 set forth the information contained in the application, in a form as pre-  
20 scribed by the department. All identification cards issued on or after  
21 January 1, 1993, shall not contain the applicant's social security number.  
22 An applicant's social security number shall be exempt from disclosure ex-  
23 cept for inquiries from agencies or institutions authorized to obtain such  
24 information by federal law or regulation, from peace officers, or from jury  
25 commissioners. Each card shall have printed on it the applicant's full name,  
26 date of birth, Idaho residence address, sex, weight, height, eye color, and  
27 hair color and shall ~~be issued~~ include a distinguishing number assigned to  
28 the applicant. If an applicant has submitted an application pursuant to the  
29 provisions of chapter 58, title 19, Idaho Code, then the applicant's iden-  
30 tification card shall contain his or her alternative Idaho mailing address  
31 in place of his or her Idaho residence address. Each card shall also have  
32 printed on it the name of this state, the date of issuance, and the date of ex-  
33 piration. An identification card shall not be valid until it has been signed  
34 on the signature line by the applicant. Each card shall bear upon it a color  
35 photograph of the applicant, which shall be taken by the examiner at the time  
36 of application. The photograph shall be taken without headgear or other  
37 clothing or device that disguises or otherwise conceals the face or head of  
38 the applicant. A waiver may be granted by the department allowing the appli-  
39 cant to wear headgear or other head covering for medical, religious or safety  
40 purposes as long as the face is not disguised or otherwise concealed. At the  
41 request of the applicant, an identification card may contain a statement or  
42 indication of the medical condition of the applicant.

43 (2) No person shall receive an identification card unless and until he  
44 surrenders to the department all identification cards in his possession is-  
45 sued to him by Idaho or any other jurisdiction, or any driver's license is-  
46 sued by any other jurisdiction within the United States, or until he executes  
47 an affidavit that he does not possess an identification card or any driver's  
48 license.

1 (3) Identification cards issued to persons under eighteen (18) years of  
2 age shall include a notation "under 18 until (month, day, year)," and iden-  
3 tification cards issued to persons eighteen (18) years of age to twenty-one  
4 (21) years of age shall include a notation "under 21 until (month, day,  
5 year)." The nonrefundable fee for a four (4) year identification card issued  
6 to persons twenty-one (21) years of age or older shall be fifteen dollars  
7 (\$15.00), of which ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be retained by the county  
8 and credited to the current expense fund, and five dollars (\$5.00) shall be  
9 deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the highway distribution  
10 account. The nonrefundable fee for identification cards issued to persons  
11 under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be ten dollars (\$10.00), of which  
12 five dollars (\$5.00) shall be retained by the authorized issuing agent or,  
13 if issued by the county, shall be credited to the current expense fund, and  
14 five dollars (\$5.00) shall be deposited in the state treasury to the credit  
15 of the highway distribution account. The nonrefundable fee for an eight (8)  
16 year identification card shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), of which  
17 fifteen dollars (\$15.00) shall be retained by the authorized issuing agent  
18 or, if issued by the county, shall be credited to the current expense fund,  
19 and ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be deposited in the state treasury to the  
20 credit of the highway distribution account. At the option of the applicant,  
21 the identification card issued to a person twenty-one (21) years of age or  
22 older shall expire either on the card holder's birthday in the fourth year or  
23 the eighth year following issuance of the card, except as otherwise provided  
24 in subsection (7) of this section. Every identification card issued to a  
25 person under eighteen (18) years of age shall expire five (5) days after the  
26 person's eighteenth birthday, except as otherwise provided in subsection  
27 (7) of this section. Every identification card issued to a person eighteen  
28 (18) years of age but under twenty-one (21) years of age shall expire five (5)  
29 days after the person's twenty-first birthday, except as otherwise provided  
30 in subsection (7) of this section.

31 (4) Individuals required to register in compliance with section 3 of  
32 the federal military selective service act, 50 U.S.C. App. 451 et seq., as  
33 amended, shall be provided an opportunity to fulfill such registration re-  
34 quirements in conjunction with an application for an identification card.  
35 Any registration information so supplied shall be transmitted by the depart-  
36 ment to the selective service system.

37 (5) Every identification card, except those issued to persons under  
38 twenty-one (21) years of age, shall be renewable on or before its expiration,  
39 but not more than twenty-five (25) months before, and upon application and  
40 payment of the required fee.

41 (6) The applicant for an identification card must submit proof of iden-  
42 tity and citizenship status acceptable to the examiner or the department and  
43 date of birth as set forth in a certified copy of his birth certificate. When  
44 a certified copy of his birth certificate or a delayed birth certificate is  
45 impossible to obtain from a vital statistics agency, another government-is-  
46 sued document may be submitted that provides satisfactory evidence of a per-  
47 son's full legal name and date of birth acceptable to the examiner or the de-  
48 partment.

49 (7) Every identification card issued to a person who is a citizen of  
50 the United States ~~may~~ shall, where possible, include the notation "USA." Ev-



1 every identification card issued to a person who is not a citizen or permanent  
2 legal resident of the United States shall have an expiration date that is  
3 the same date as the end of lawful stay in the United States as indicated on  
4 documents issued and verified by the department of homeland security, pro-  
5 vided however, that the expiration date shall not extend beyond the expira-  
6 tion date for the same category of identification card issued to citizens.  
7 Persons whose department of homeland security documents do not state an ex-  
8 piration date shall be issued an identification card with an expiration date  
9 of one (1) year from the date of issuance.

10 (8) When an identification card has been expired for less than twenty-  
11 five (25) months, the renewal of the identification card shall start from  
12 the original date of expiration, regardless of the year in which the applica-  
13 tion for renewal is made. If the identification card is expired for more than  
14 twenty-five (25) months, the application shall expire, at the option of the  
15 applicant, on the applicant's birthday in the fourth year or the eighth year  
16 following reissuance of the identification card, except as otherwise pro-  
17 vided in subsection (7) of this section.

18 (9) (a) If an Idaho identification card has expired or will expire and  
19 the identification card holder is temporarily out of state, except  
20 on active military duty, the identification card holder may request  
21 in writing on a form prescribed by the department an extension of the  
22 identification card. The request shall be accompanied by the fee  
23 fixed in section 49-306, Idaho Code, and the extension shall be no more  
24 than a twelve (12) month period. If the department determines that an  
25 extension of the identification card is necessary, it may issue an iden-  
26 tification card showing the date to which the expired identification  
27 card is extended. Identification card extensions are limited to two (2)  
28 consecutive extensions per identification card holder.

29 (b) Upon returning to the state of Idaho, the identification card  
30 holder shall, within ten (10) days, apply for a renewal of the expired  
31 identification card and surrender the extended identification card and  
32 the expired identification card.

33 (10) An Idaho identification card issued to any person prior to serving  
34 on active duty in the armed forces of the United States, or a member of the  
35 immediate family accompanying such a person, if valid and in full force and  
36 effect upon entering active duty, shall remain in full force and effect and  
37 shall, upon application, be extended for a period of four (4) years as long  
38 as active duty continues, and the identification card shall remain in full  
39 force and effect sixty (60) days following the date the card holder is re-  
40 leased from active duty.

41 (11) A person possessing an identification card who desires to donate  
42 any or all organs or tissue in the event of death, and who has completed a  
43 document of gift pursuant to the provisions for donation of anatomical gifts  
44 as set forth in chapter 34, title 39, Idaho Code, may, at the option of the  
45 donor, indicate this desire on the identification card by the imprinting of  
46 the word "donor" on the identification card. The provisions of this subsec-  
47 tion shall apply to persons possessing an identification card who are fif-  
48 teen (15) years of age or older but less than eighteen (18) years of age if  
49 the requirements provided in chapter 34, title 39, Idaho Code, have been com-  
50 plied with.

1 (12) A person possessing an identification card or an applicant for an  
2 identification card who is a person with a permanent disability may request  
3 that the notation "permanently disabled" be imprinted on the identification  
4 card, provided the person presents written certification from a licensed  
5 physician verifying that the person's stated impairment qualifies as a per-  
6 manent disability according to the provisions of section 49-117, Idaho Code.

7 (13) A person who is a veteran may request that his or her status as such  
8 be designated on an identification card at no additional cost. Any such re-  
9 quest shall be accompanied by proof of being a current or former member of  
10 the United States armed forces. Upon request and submission of satisfactory  
11 proof, the department shall indicate such person's status as a veteran on any  
12 identification card issued pursuant to the provisions of this section. Such  
13 designation shall be made upon original issuance or renewal of an identifi-  
14 cation card. Designation shall also be made on any duplicate identification  
15 card issued, provided that the fee for such duplicate card is paid in accor-  
16 dance with this section.

17 (14) Satisfactory proof of being a current or former member of the  
18 United States armed forces must be furnished by an applicant to the de-  
19 partment before a designation of veteran status will be indicated on any  
20 identification card. Acceptable proof shall be a copy of form DD214 or an  
21 equivalent document or statement from the department of veterans affairs  
22 that identifies a character of service upon separation as "honorable" or  
23 "general under honorable conditions."

24 (15) In the case of a name change, the applicant shall provide legal doc-  
25 umentation to verify the change in accordance with department rules.

26 (16) Whenever any person, after applying for or receiving an identifi-  
27 cation card, shall move from the address shown on the application or on the  
28 identification card issued, that person shall, within thirty (30) days, no-  
29 tify the transportation department in writing of the old and new addresses.

30 (17) The department shall cancel any identification card upon determin-  
31 ing that the person was not entitled to the issuance of the identification  
32 card or that the person failed to give the required and correct information  
33 in his application or committed fraud in making the application. Upon can-  
34 cellation, the person shall surrender the canceled identification card to  
35 the department.

36 (18) If any person shall fail to return to the department the identifi-  
37 cation card as required, the department may direct any peace officer to se-  
38 cure its possession and return the identification card to the department.

39 (19) The department may issue a no-fee identification card to an indi-  
40 vidual whose driver's license has been canceled and voluntarily surrendered  
41 as provided in section 49-322 (5), Idaho Code. The identification card may be  
42 renewed at no cost to the applicant as long as the driver's license remains  
43 canceled.

44 (20) It is an infraction for any person to fail to notify the department  
45 of a change of address as required by the provisions of subsection (16) of  
46 this section.

47 ~~(16)~~ (21) The department may issue an initial four (4) year no-fee iden-  
48 tification card to an individual who is homeless. The department shall es-  
49 tablish a form for verification of homelessness pursuant to this section.  
50 Such form shall require the signature of an outreach worker or service worker

1 verifying that the individual is homeless and attesting to the individual's  
2 residency at an Idaho relief agency or shelter. An applicant issued an iden-  
3 tification card under the provisions of this subsection shall be entitled  
4 to one (1) free replacement. Subsequent replacements and renewals of this  
5 identification card will be subject to the fees imposed in this section.

6 (22) The department shall issue a four (4) year no-fee identification  
7 card to any individual eighteen (18) years of age or older who has not pos-  
8 sessed a current driver's license in the preceding six (6) months and who  
9 indicates on the application that an identification card is needed to com-  
10 ply with voter registration or voting requirements. An applicant issued an  
11 identification card under this subsection shall be entitled to one (1) free  
12 replacement. Such applicants are entitled to no-fee renewals as long as the  
13 applicant meets the requirements of this subsection at the time of renewal.

14 SECTION 9. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
15 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after  
16 July 1, 2023.
