- RELATING TO PROPERTY; AMENDING CHAPTER 3, TITLE 55, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 55-314, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT FEES IMPOSED
 ON RESIDENTIAL TENANTS SHALL BE REASONABLE AND TO PROHIBIT FEES, FINES,
 ASSESSMENTS, INTERESTS, OR OTHER COSTS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES;
 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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8 SECTION 1. That Chapter 3, Title 55, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
 9 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des 10 ignated as Section 55-314, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

11 55-314. LIMITATION ON FEES FOR TENANTS OF A RENTAL PROPERTY. (1) Any 12 fees imposed on a residential tenant, including fees for the late payment of 13 rent, shall be reasonable.

14 (2) An owner may not charge to the tenant of a rental property a fee,15 fine, assessment, interest, or other cost:

(a) In an amount greater than that agreed upon in the rental agreement;or

(b) That	is not	included	in the	rental	agreement,	unless:
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- (i) The rental agreement is an oral agreement; or
- (ii) The rental agreement is written, and the owner provides the
 tenant a written thirty (30) day notice of the change in the fee,
 fine, assessment, interest, or other cost.

23 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 24 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
 25 July 1, 2023.
