SENATE BILL NO. 1134

BY FINANCE COMMITTEE

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE COMMISSION ON AGING; APPROPRIATING MON-
EYS TO THE COMMISSION ON AGING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; LIMITING THE NUMBER
OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNT-
ABILITY REPORTS; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE COMMISSION ON
AGING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE COM-
MISSION ON AGING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND
PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Commission on Aging the
following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes
from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
Idaho Code, the Commission on Aging is authorized no more than fourteen
(14.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July
1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, unless specifically authorized by the Gover-
nor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly
of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. Funds specifically identified in
statute or in an appropriation act as intended for a certain purpose may be
used only for that purpose. All funds provided in this act shall be subject
to accountability reports and management reviews in accordance with Section
67-702, Idaho Code.

1 SECTION 4. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-
2 ter 103, Laws of 2022, and any other appropriation provided by law, there
3 is hereby appropriated to the Commission on Aging \$345,100 from the Federal
4 COVID-19 Relief Fund to be expended for operating expenditures for the pe-
5 riod July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, for the purpose of adult protective
6 services.

7 SECTION 5. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-
8 ter 103, Laws of 2022, and any other appropriation provided by law, there
9 is hereby appropriated to the Commission on Aging \$750,000 from the Federal
10 Grant Fund to be expended for trustee and benefit payments for the period
11 July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, for the purpose of adult protective ser-
12 vices.

13 SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, Sections 4 and 5 of this act shall be in full force and ef-
15 fect on and after passage and approval, and Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this act
16 shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2023.
