2	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; AMENDING CHAPTER 6, TITLE 49, IDAHO CODE, BY THE
3	ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 49-677, IDAHO CODE, TO PROHIBIT SMOKING, VA-
4	PING, OR IGNITING AN OBJECT OR ACTIVATING A DEVICE FOR THE PURPOSE OF
5	SMOKING OR VAPING IN A MOTOR VEHICLE IF A MINOR IS PRESENT, TO PROVIDE
6	THAT ENFORCEMENT OF THIS SECTION MAY BE ACCOMPLISHED ONLY AS A SECONDARY
7	ACTION, TO PROVIDE A PENALTY, TO PROVIDE THAT CONVICTION UNDER THIS SEC-
8	TION SHALL NOT RESULT IN VIOLATION POINT COUNTS OR BE CONSIDERED A MOV-
9	ING TRAFFIC VIOLATION, AND TO DEFINE TERMS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
10	AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 6, Title 49, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 49-677, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 49-677. SMOKING OR VAPING IN MOTOR VEHICLE WITH MINOR PRESENT. (1) If a person under the age of eighteen (18) years is present in a motor vehicle, no operator of or passenger in the vehicle shall:
  - (a) Smoke or vape;

- (b) Ignite an object for the purpose of smoking; or
- (c) Activate a device for the purpose of vaping.
- (2) Enforcement of this section by law enforcement officers may be accomplished only as a secondary action when the operator of the motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected violation of another law.
- (3) A person issued a citation pursuant to this section shall be subject to a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00). A conviction under this section shall not result in violation point counts as prescribed in section 49-326, Idaho Code, nor shall such a conviction be deemed to be a moving traffic violation for the purpose of establishing rates of motor vehicle insurance charged by a casualty insurer.
  - (4) For purposes of this section:
  - (a) "Smoke" means to inhale and exhale the fumes of a tobacco product or another drug; and
  - (b) "Vape" means to inhale vapor through the mouth from a device that heats up and vaporizes a liquid or solid.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2023.
