NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; PROVIDING FOR AC COUNTABILITY REPORTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EF FECTIVE DATE.

8 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Commission on the Arts 9 the following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense 10 classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 11 2024:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Commission on the Arts is authorized no more than ten (10.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. Funds specifically
identified in statute or in an appropriation act as intended for a certain
purpose may be used only for that purpose. All funds provided in this act
shall be subject to accountability reports and management reviews in accor dance with Section 67-702, Idaho Code.

SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on an after July
1, 2023.
