RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL; AP PROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2024; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT
POSITIONS; PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS; PROVIDING AGENCY DI RECTION; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR THE ARPA STATE FISCAL
RECOVERY FUND; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR THE GENERAL
FUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Workforce Development Council the following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Workforce Development Council is authorized no more than eleven (11.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

32 SECTION 3. ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. Funds specifically identified in 33 statute or in an appropriation act as intended for a certain purpose may be 34 used only for that purpose. All funds provided in this act shall be subject 35 to accountability reports and management reviews in accordance with Section 36 67-702, Idaho Code.

SECTION 4. CNA CERTIFICATION STUDY. The Workforce Development Council 1 2 shall continue evaluating the certification pipeline for certified nursing assistants (CNAs) and provide a report to the Joint Finance-Appropriations 3 Committee by December 1, 2023. The report shall include at a minimum: rec-4 5 ommendations to provide an effective regulatory process such that a pipeline of CNAs are developed in alignment with the needs of employers; recommenda-6 7 tions to provide readily accessible education for the profession statewide; and recommendations as to how a uniform disciplinary process could be imple-8 mented for reports of abuse and neglect. 9

10 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated to the Workforce Development Council any unexpended and unencumbered bal-11 ances appropriated or reappropriated to the Workforce Development Council 12 from the ARPA State Fiscal Recovery Fund for fiscal year 2023, to be used 13 for nonrecurring expenditures for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 14 15 2024. The Office of the State Controller shall confirm the reappropriation amount, by fund, expense class, and program, with the Legislative Services 16 Office prior to processing the reappropriation authorized herein. 17

SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated 18 19 to the Workforce Development Council any unexpended and unencumbered balances appropriated or reappropriated to the Workforce Development Council 20 from the General Fund for fiscal year 2023, not to exceed \$125,000, to be used 21 for nonrecurring expenditures for a CNA study for the period July 1, 2023, 22 23 through June 30, 2024. The Office of the State Controller shall confirm the reappropriation amount, by fund, expense class, and program, with the Leg-24 islative Services Office prior to processing the reappropriation authorized 25 herein. 26

27 SECTION 7. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 28 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 29 July 1, 2023.
