What is the IDEP?

Contract between State of Idaho, Idaho State University and Creighton University in Omaha,

 1st year classes at ISU with remaining 3 at Creighton

Nebraska

Program started in 1981

Program Highlights:

- Cost effective: Costs Idaho 41% of national average cost per dental student
- High return rate: >65% of IDEP graduates return to Idaho to work
 - 16 previous graduates returned to Idaho in the past 2.5 years

Outstanding students:

- near perfect 1st time pass rate on board exams
- 4 recent IDEP graduates ranked in top 5 of Creighton Class (out of 85)

IDEP Reappropriation (last year)

- IDEP historically pays the contract payment to Creighton by June of the current year
- Creighton did not invoice IDEP for the FY2021 contract payment until June 27, 2021
- Invoice was paid for FY2021 on July 3, 2021 with FY2022 appropriation
- FY 2021 appropriation was reverted to the General Fund
- One time funding of reverted funds to make FY2022 IDEP Contract Payment – thank you!!

IDEP Maintenance Budget

The following maintenance adjustments are requested to keep the program functioning

- \$3,800 for personnel benefit costs
- \$94,800 for contract cost escalation
- \$4,400 for change in employee compensation
