Chairman Weber called the meeting to order at 1:04 p.m.

Chairman Weber introduced the Committee secretary and thanked **Rep. Dixon (1)** and **Rep. Necochea** for acting as minutes proofreaders. He explained the deadline and approval process for accepting RSs for an introductory hearing.

RS 30323: **Rep. Boyle** presented **RS 30323**, which will add rattlesnakes to the list of predatory animals.

MOTION: **Rep. Dixon (1)** made a motion to introduce **RS 30323**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 30355: **Rep. Dixon (24)** presented **RS 30355**, which will require homeowner's associations to provide payoff statements to property owners free of charge. No other fees will be affected.

In response to a committee question, **Rep. Dixon (24)** explained that while current Idaho Code prohibits this, the legislation's amendment clarifies that charges for statements of account will be in violation of the Idaho Consumer Protection Act.

MOTION: **Rep. Burns** made a motion to introduce **RS 30355**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 30356: **Rep. Dixon (24)** presented **RS 30356** relating to unfair service agreements in real estate. These agreements are attached to property, can be expensive and can cause problems years later when property owners disposes of their properties. This legislation defines what a service agreement is and limits the agreements to one year.

MOTION: **Rep. Burns** made a motion to introduce **RS 30356**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 30379: **Rep. Moyle** presented **RS 30379**, which will prohibit data center properties, exempt from equipment sales taxes under current Idaho law, from being included in urban renewal district revenue allocations. The intent is to ensure a data center's property taxes go to local taxing districts that provide services to the area where the data center is located.

In answer to a committee question, **Rep. Moyle** stated it was his intent to assign the legislation to a committee.

MOTION: Rep. Dixon made a motion to introduce **RS 30379. Motion carried by voice vote.**

ADJOURN: There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 1:16 p.m.

RS 30396: **Rep. Palmer** presented **RS 30396**, proposed legislation to redefine "congestion mitigation."

RS 30408: **Jason Kreizenbeck**, Lobby Idaho, presented **RS 30408**, proposed legislation to create a definition of "electric fuel" for commercial vehicles in Idaho.

RS 30414: **Rep. Skaug** presented **RS 30414**, proposed legislation amending the methods of execution to include the firing squad as a secondary method when lethal injection is not available.

In response to a committee question about meeting the Eighth Amendment, **Rep. Skaug** explained the proposed method could result in about 10 seconds of extreme pain, but lethal injections are botched six to eight percent of the time and, in his opinion, this method of execution is more certain and humane. **Rep. Dixon** stated several states are using this method of execution and have met the test.

MOTION: **Rep. Dixon** made a motion to introduce **RS 30414**. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Necochea** requested to be recorded as voting **NAY**.

RS 30422: **Rep. Ehlers** presented **RS 30422**, proposed legislation adds immunity protection relating to automatic external defibrillator access.

MOTION: Rep. Dixon made a motion to introduce **RS 30422. Motion carried by voice vote.**

It eliminates the Public Defense Commission and establishes the Office of State Public Defender and District Public Defenders for each of the state's Judicial Districts.

MOTION: **Rep. Manwaring** made a motion to introduce **RS 30446**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

Rep. Blanksma turned the gavel over to **Chairman Weber**.

RS 30490: **Rep. Blanksma** presented **RS 30490**, which replaces **H 55**. This legislation ensures certain funding is used specifically for the administration, maintenance, construction and development of local bridges and highways.

MOTION: **Rep. Dixon (1)** made a motion to introduce **RS 30490**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

In answer to a question from the Committee, **Rep. Blanksma** explained the new RS addresses concerns the original language about maintenance was too restrictive.

RS 30500: **Rep. Dixon (24)** presented **RS 30500**, which is replaces **H 158**. This legislation relates to unfair service agreements in real estate. She explained the RS was amended to more clearly define the responsibility of county recorders.

MOTION: **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 30500**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

Rep. Manwaring expressed appreciation for the amendment.

It asks the governor to enlist resources to fight the claim, and Idaho's congressional leaders to request the justice department withdraw the lawsuit. It also authorizes distribution of the memorial through congressional channels.

RS 30454: **Rep. Handy** presented **RS 30454**. This legislation reduces the time from five years to three years before a juvenile criminal record can be expunged.

This legislation fixes the VIN matching bill passed four years ago. It is expected to reduce the number of notices sent by 30 to 50 percent and focus on catching real violators.

RS 30572: **Rep. Dixon (1)** presented **RS 30572**, relating to initiatives and referendum signature gatherers. It will require paid signature gatherers to register with the Secretary of State and complete training.

MOTION: **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 30572**.

Responding to a question from the committee, **Rep. Dixon (1)** stated the registration and training requirements are intended for paid signature gatherers only, but he would be amenable to changing the training requirement to include all signature gatherers if the committee suggested doing so. The committee declined.

RS 30561: **Rep. Boyle** presented **RS 30561**. This memorial solidifies Idaho's opposition to proposed Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) water quality standards based on 19th century tribal treaties. The proposed rules will circumvent Idaho's scientifically established water quality standards previously approved by the EPA.

Rep. Blanskma requested the fiscal note be updated to ensure it meets Senate scrutiny.

MOTION: **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 30561**. **Motion carried by voice vote. Reps. Necochea and Burns** requested to be recorded as voting **NAY**.
