## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

## RS31441 / H0650

This appropriation to the Commission on the Arts provides enhancements to the FY 2025 maintenance budget that include an increase in grant funding from the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) and the additional 2% change in employee compensation.

## **FISCAL NOTE**

This appropriation provides an additional \$65,400 to the maintenance appropriation provided to the Commission on the Arts found in House Bill 459. Table 1 below shows incremental adjustments to the budget for FY 2025, of which \$65,400 is ongoing and there are no onetime appropriations. Table 2 shows the adjustments leading to the FY 2025 Total. The total budget for the Commission on the Arts is \$2,253,100.
