BY APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

1 AN ACT
 2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF DRUG POLICY; APPROPRIATING
 3 ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE OFFICE OF DRUG POLICY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025;
 4 PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND
 5 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law,
 8 there is hereby appropriated to the Office of Drug Policy the following
 9 amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes from the
 10 listed funds for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025:

23 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated
 24 to the Office of Drug Policy any unexpended and unencumbered balance appro-
 25 priated or reappropriated to the Office of Drug Policy from the American Res-
 26 cue Plan Fund for fiscal year 2024, in the amount not to exceed \$775,100 from
 27 the American Rescue Plan Fund, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures re-
 28 lated to drug use prevention services for the period July 1, 2024, through
 29 June 30, 2025. The Office of the State Controller shall confirm the reappro-
 30 priation amount, by fund, expense class, and program, with the Legislative
 31 Services Office prior to processing the reappropriation authorized herein.

32 SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 33 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
 34 July 1, 2024.
