AN ACT

2 RELATING TO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND HIGHWAY OFFICERS; AMENDING SECTION

3 40-605, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING THE LAYING OUT,

4 WIDENING, INCREASING TRAVEL LANES, OR STRAIGHTENING OF HIGHWAYS; AND

5 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 40-605, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

40-605. LAYING OUT OF NEW HIGHWAYS -- WIDENING, CHANGING INCREASING TRAVEL LANES, OR STRAIGHTENING OF EXISTING HIGHWAYS -- PURCHASE OF RIGHTS-OF-WAY BY AGREEMENT. Commissioners may lay out new highways within the county as they determine to be necessary for the primary benefit of motorists. The right-of-way of any highway shall not be less than fifty (50) feet wide. rexcept in exceptional cases. Commissioners may also change the width or location or straighten lines of any highway under their jurisdiction. Commissioners may only expand the existing width, increase the number of travel lanes, or straighten lanes of any highway under their jurisdiction. If, in the laying out, widening, changing increasing travel lanes, or straightening of any highway it shall become necessary to take private property, the commissioners or their director of highways shall cause a survey of the proposed highway to be made, together with an accurate description of the lands required. The commissioners shall endeavor to agree with each owner for the purchase of a right-of-way over his land included within the description. If they are able to agree with the owner, the commissioners may purchase the land out of the county highway fund under their control, and the land shall then be conveyed to the county for the use and purpose of highways.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
