AMENDMENT TO THE RESOLUTION

2 On page 1 of the printed resolution, following line 7, insert:

3 "WHEREAS, State Highway 95 is the primary north-south highway in Idaho
4 and is a vital transportation corridor between the Boise metropolitan area
5 and the Canadian border; and";

6 delete lines 9 and 10, and insert: "traffic on State Highway 55 and State
7 Highway 95, resulting in significant traffic congestion during high-volume
8 periods, including the months of June,"; following line 24, insert:

9 "WHEREAS, a railroad right-of-way that is not currently being used fol-
10 lows a similar route as Highway 55 between Horseshoe Bend and Cascade; and

11 WHEREAS, State Highway 55 and State Highway 95 are vital to the
12 economies of the communities within their transportation corridors, and it
13 is critical that such communities not be adversely affected by any changes to
14 such transportation corridors; and";

15 in line 30, delete "central Idaho" and insert: "Canada"; and in line 42,
16 delete "central Idaho" and insert: "Canada".

17 On page 2, in line 8, delete "and of" and insert: "unused railroad
18 rights-of-way,"; delete line 9, and insert: "travel between Canada and
19 the Treasure Valley, and the economic impacts of any proposed solutions on
20 existing communities within the State Highway 55 and State Highway 95 corri-
21 dors."; and in line 18, following "issues," insert: "economics,".
