A JOINT RESOLUTION

- PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 9, ARTICLE IX OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE
 STATE OF IDAHO, RELATING TO SCHOOL ATTENDANCE; STATING THE QUESTION TO
 BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORATE; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO
 PREPARE THE STATEMENTS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF
 STATE TO PUBLISH THE AMENDMENT AND ARGUMENTS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
- 7 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Section 9, Article IX of the Constitution of the State9 of Idaho be amended to read as follows:

Section 9. COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL. The legislature 10 may require by law that every child shall attend the public schools 11 of the state, throughout the period between the ages of six and 12 eighteen years, unless educated by other means, as provided by law. 13 Custodial parents or quardians of any minor child in Idaho shall 14 have the fundamental right to privately home educate such child or 15 to cause such child to be privately educated. Those who privately 16 home educate such children shall be free from government regulation 17 of such education and shall not be entitled to public funds to sup-18 port such education. 19

20 SECTION 2. The question to be submitted to the electors of the State of21 Idaho at the next general election shall be as follows:

"Shall Section 9, Article IX of the Constitution of the State of Idaho be amended to provide that parents and guardians have the fundamental right to privately home educate their children or to cause their children to be privately educated and to provide that parents or guardians who privately home educate their children shall be free from government regulation of such education and shall not be entitled to public funds to support such education?"

28 SECTION 3. The Legislative Council is directed to prepare the state-29 ments required by Section 67-453, Idaho Code, and file the same.

30 SECTION 4. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to publish this 31 proposed constitutional amendment and arguments as required by law.
